Math-A-Thon 2020 is happening now!

Math-A-Thon is an annual tradition where student “mathletes” actively participate in fundraising for a cause while sharpening and sharing their math skills with family and friends! This year, **students are aiming to raise \$18,000 or more in support of St. Michael’s comprehensive STEAM program** - Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math – the foundation of equipping our students with 21st century skills.

Here is how it works: Students have completed a grade-appropriate math exam and it has been scored by their teachers. Now students will seek donations from family and friends, either as a pledge for every correct math problem (maximum of 20) or as a flat-rate pledge in support of their efforts. The pledge drive runs from January 31-February 12 and can be paid directly to the student or ONLINE!

Here are some tips & quick facts to make it easier.

- I am participating in a Math-a-Thon at St. Michael's School. I took a math test and it was graded by my teacher.
- All students are asking for pledges from family and friends based on this test to raise money for our school's STEAM program – activities and lessons in science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics.
- I would appreciate it if you would support me and my school. You can either make a pledge for every point I earn on the math test (worth up to 20 points) OR you can make a flat rate pledge of any amount. For example, if you pledge \$1 per point, and my test score is an 18, your donation would be \$18.
- If you decide to make a pledge, I will need the donation by February 11, so I can turn everything in to my teacher on the February 12th.
- You can pay in cash or check – made out to **St. Michael's School** (please write "Math-a-thon" in the memo) or you can even donate online at our school's website: www.stmichael.net/mathathon. All donations are tax-deductible.
- The school is awarding prizes to the top three students who bring in the most donations and the top homeroom will get a party. I am working to be one of those three!
