Thanks to all involved with our action-packed Science Fair Week, from the Edible Car Race to the STEM Festival to the Science Fair projects themselves. The great turnout Friday evening was a testament to our community's support of STEM education. Now for all the things going on THIS week...

Events This Week:

- Student Council has busy days ahead. The third trimester homeroom representative elections are taking place this week. The Council is also selling carnations Monday through Wednesday (2/10-2/12), to be distributed during the last period Friday (2/14). Each flower is \$2, and fifth through eighth graders may purchase them. Finally, this month Student Council is joining forces with the Lower School to raise money for WIRES- an Australian wildlife rescue organization (https://www.wires.org.au/about-wires). Students are encouraged to bring donations for this worthy group on Thursdays this month.
- The **Seventh Grade** is going off campus to enjoy group-building games at Playformance on the morning of <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>February 11</u>. They will be back at school around lunchtime.
- This year's Math-a-thon is nearing completion! The deadline to turn in donations is Wednesday, February 12. Prizes will be awarded to the top three students as well as the top classrooms in both Upper and Lower Schools. If total pledges exceed \$14,000, the entire school will celebrate with Free Dress for a day, and prizes will compound with every \$2,000 beyond that mark.

- Students can participate in the next \$2 "Fee Dress" Day on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>February 12</u>, followed soon by our next **Relaxed (Free) Dress Day** on Valentine's Day, <u>February 14</u>.

- Parent information nights for the 6th grade **Crow Canyon** trip and 7th grade **Catalina Island** trip are both scheduled for the evening of <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>February</u> 12, from 5:30 6:15 p.m.
